Schedule of Events

Approx start time 10.30am

- Class 1** Best Rider - Lead Rein Best Rider Class is to show that you are the best rider in your age group. The judge will be looking at position, aids used, control and accuracy. Riders in the class will ride around together and then will do an individual show.
- Class 2** Best Rider - 10 and Under
- Class 3** Best Rider - 11 -16
- Class 4** Best Rider Seniors

These classes may be judged together dependant on time and number of entries – there will be separate prizes for each category

Approx start time 12.00pm

- Class 5** Best turned out livery horse or pony, open to those with their own horse or pony only

This is a mounted class.

Approx start time 12.30pm

- Class 6** Best Cob/Coloured Horse or Pony – Open to all

This class is mounted. The judge will be looking for good conformation, action and a well mannered horse/pony.

Approx start time 2.00pm

- Class 7** Fancy Dress

This class can be mounted or un-mounted with all age groups together. The more imaginative the better! Please try costumes on the horse/pony before the day.

Approx 2.30pm – 3.30pm

Clear Round Show-jumping at varying heights

£ 6.00 for 2 clear rounds, own horse or pony

£ 10.00 for 2 clear rounds, MEC horse or pony

Approx start time 3.30pm

Class 8 PICK YOUR OWN LINE – ACCUMULATOR

Jumping – Ponies up to 14.2hh

Class 9 PICK YOUR OWN LINE – ACCUMULATOR

Jumping – Horses Over 14.2 hh

Jumping with a difference! You have 1 minute to jump as many fences as you like choosing your own course. Fences will have points allocated to them depending on the difficulty. Points get deducted for knock downs and refusals. The highest score wins.
