Open to all riders, with or without their own horse

- ✓ **Class 1a.** Dressage Only - MEC Walk/Trot Test 2011.
Open to any rider that has not been placed in any dressage competition (excludes MEC dressage competitions).
- ✓ **Class 1b.** Combined Training - Height of Fences 1ft 9" (max 60cm).
Open to any rider not competed under British Dressage affiliated rules. Not to have placed first more than 3 times in any show jump competition.(excluding MEC show jumping competitions) No BSJA registered combinations may enter this class

- ✓ **Class 2a.** Dressage Only – MEC Beginners Test 2011.
Open to any rider that has not been placed in any dressage competition before (excludes MEC dressage competitions).
- ✓ **Class 2b.** Combined Training - Height of Fences 2ft 0" (max 70cm).
Open to any rider not competed under British Dressage affiliated rules. Not to have been placed first more than 3 times in any show jump competition, (excluding MEC show jumping competitions) No BSJA registered combinations may enter this class (except non competitively)

Withdrawals:- In the unfortunate event of withdrawal, please advise the office by Mid-day Saturday prior to the competition. We regret **no refunds** will be made.

- ✓ **Times:** Please ring 0121 311 1601 on the **SUNDAY** preceding the competition date between 4.00 p.m. & 6.00 pm or check the website www.middletonequestrian.co.uk
- ✓ Exact times for show jumping phase will not be given. But course heights will change and you need to make sure you have jumped before your height has finished. Check with office on day for time you need to have jumped by. The wearing of back protectors is recommended for show jumping.
- ✓ Any special requests must be clearly put onto entry.
- ✓ Classes will be judged under BD rules and BSJA rules and correct dress must be worn. Commanders allowed for all dressage tests.
- ✓ Horses may only enter twice in each class competitively with different riders.

RULES & CONDITIONS:

MEC and / or the organising committee cannot be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever other than liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of the competition
A horse/pony may only be ridden twice in each test.

HEALTH & SAFETY: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and steward.

All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats marked BS / EN 1384, PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SE1 with a strap properly adjusted and fastened. **Correct dress & footwear to be worn.** Horses & ponies must be 4 years old and over. Entries accepted at rider's risk. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The organisers' decision is final.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
