Welcome to Middleton Equestrian Centre

We hope you enjoy yourself whilst at the Centre, in the interest of your health and safety we would like you to read the following information.

Horse riding can be a dangerous activity so please take care of yourself and everyone else whilst at the Centre.

Always wear the appropriate protective equipment for the activity you intend to undertake, it is a Centre rule however, that a proprietary safety hat is worn at all times whilst mounted. This hat must be secured by a chin strap at all times and, whilst it would not be possible nor desirable for the site staff to inspect each hat, we recommend that any hat used is properly fitted, conforms to BSI standard, and has not been dropped or worn after the rider has suffered a significant fall.

When using the facilities of the Centre, particularly the cross country course or the show jumping arena, we would request that you limit yourself to those jumps that lie within your competence, and that you are accompanied by a qualified instructor, before attempting more difficult obstacles.

Do not undertake any activity that will unnecessarily endanger you, or anyone else, and, should a member of the Middleton Equestrian Centre team issue an instruction, we respectfully ask you to follow it promptly.

Before using any of the Middleton Equestrian Centre facilities every rider must report to the reception on non-show days, and to the event organiser on show days. This must be done every time you visit the site, as a new rider disclaimer form is required for each event.

Should you be unlucky enough to suffer a fall, please ensure that you log the incident in the reception accident book. Your own insurance cover may be invalidated if this procedure is not followed. **WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND YOU TAKE OUT YOUR OWN HORSE & RIDER INSURANCE.**
